Fr. Neil Dhabliwala, pastor of St. Catherine of Siena Catholic Church in Kennesaw, grew up in Atlanta and attended St. Pius X High School. Fr. Neil received a BS in Management and Information Technology from Georgia Tech in 2001. He received a Master of Divinity and an MA in Moral Theology (from Mount St. Mary's Seminary in 2008 and a Certification in Catholic Healthcare Ethics from The National Catholic Bioethics Center in 2015. Fr. Neil has been a PAC Board Member since 2017 and is currently chaplain of the Atlanta guild of the Catholic Medical Association.

ETHICAL DECISION MAKING

Richard A. Rowe, MD, graduated from Emory University in Atlanta in 1987. Dr. Rowe completed his training in neurosurgery at the Medical College of Georgia in Augusta in 1994. A retired Navy Reserve captain, Dr. Rowe served as a neurosurgeno at the National Naval Medical Center in Washington, DC, the Naval Hospital in Okinawa, Japan, and the Naval Hospital Portsmouth in Portsmouth, VA. He also served as the group surgeno for the Third Force Service Support Group, a US Marine activity in Okinawa, Japan. Dr. Rowe joined the faculty at the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences for six years before moving to Macon, Georgia, where he works at the Georgia Neurosurgical Institute. Dr. Rowe is a Catholic Medical Association guild president in Macon and a state director for the Catholic Medical Association in Georgia.
