AoA Visioning Process Homily for the Beginning of the Visioning Process

"We are the fastest growing diocese in the United States. And so, it is important that goals are clearly articulated and formulated, to respond to the needs of our people. It is appropriate that this formal process begin with the celebration of the Eucharist, the "source" and summit of the Church's life." We are in the midst of a Eucharistic Revival in the Church, which Pope Francis has described as "a renewed personal encounter with Jesus" *Christ*"—*particularly the transforming power and mercy of Jesus in the Holy Eucharist.* This is the task of evangelization – to proclaim the Gospel so that Christ may be encountered. I invite all of us to pray for the process that begins today and ask the Holy Spirit to guide and direct us in this time of discernment." Archbishop Hartmayer (1.23)

When the Visioning Process is completed, we will begin steps toward discernment of a holistic Catechists' Formation Process that at its heart is:

✤An on-going encounter with Christ

An on-going accompaniment of catechists

✤ A place where catechists become faith sharing and learning communities

Evangelizing the catechist through the proclamation of the kerygma

Emphasizing current research and strategies for evangelization for today's families.



Spiritual growth is a continual process...

Emphasize opportunities that will evangelize each other and foster spiritual growth throughout each year, moving away from "checking off" a requirement mentality.
