The National Eucharistic Pilgrimage will be coming through our archdiocese on June 21-23, along the <u>St. Juan Diego Route</u>. We ask you to please encourage your communities to <u>register</u> (at no cost) for one or more of the gatherings here in the archdiocese. As part of this historic opportunity, Archbishop Hartmayer is calling all parishes and families to participate in an archdiocesan-wide **Parish Day of Eucharistic Service on June 22**, if possible, and to ground these efforts in prayer. In addition, Catholic Charities of Atlanta will be offering an online drive this day to assist refugees who have come to the archdiocese—see <u>flyer</u> for additional details.

Other activities include a special noon Mass, celebrated by Archbishop Hartmayer, with the pilgrims in the Hyland Center at the Cathedral of Christ the King on **Sunday June 23**, followed by a Eucharistic procession, and much more!
