





#### Offertory Collections

- Covers salaries and benefits for the employees of the Church.
- Pays for utilities (gas, light, water, etc.)
- Contributes to the ministry of the Atlanta Archdiocese (10% of Total Offertory)
- Includes money brought in through candle and flower donations.

# **Capital Fund**

- This money goes directly to our Building Fund to be used for any capital projects. It allows us to grow our physical capacity and to enrich our spiritual environment.
- Committed to save \$50K each year.

#### Individual Ministries

This money is directed by the donor to specific ministries like: Religious Education, Community Outreach, Military, St. Vincent de Paul, Friends of St. Martin de Porres, Theater Ministry, etc.
