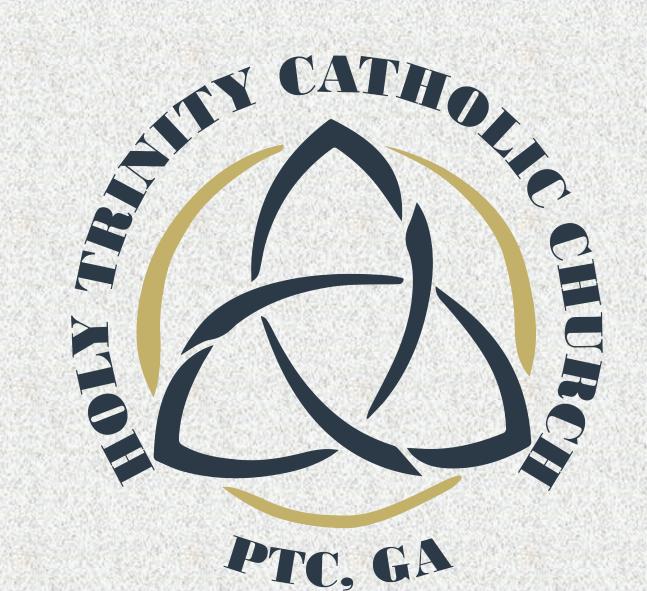

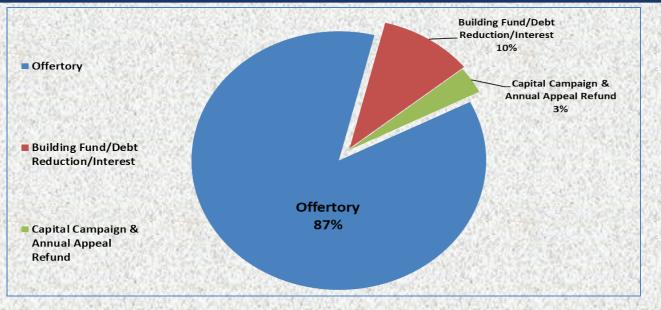

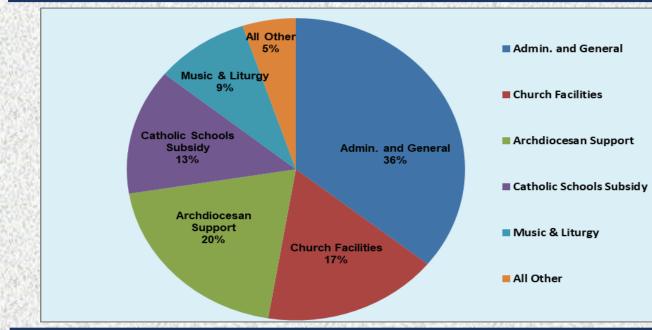
Parish Sources of Income FY 2019 - 2020
