To the Immaculate Heart of Mary Parish Family:

In partnership with IHM Director of Finance Rich Plachta, the Parish Finance Council has prepared this update to keep you informed about the financial status of the parish. For this update, we are presenting comparison of the income and expenses for the Fourth Quarter of Fiscal Year 2021-2022 (April to June) vs. Fourth Quarter of Fiscal Year 2020-2021, as well as the entire Fiscal Years.

Although we have taken significant steps toward normalcy, the impacts of COVID 19 have tapered in the Fourth Quarter. The Council and the staff are committed to remain focused on seeing that the mission of IHM remains strong during these challenging times.

Total Revenues for the Fourth Quarter were \$538,767, an increase of \$90,123 or 16% from Total Revenues of \$448,644 during the same quarter last year. The increase is primarily due to an increase in Mass attendance and the related higher offertory, and \$40,952 other donations, partly offset by non-cash investment losses. Total annual revenues of \$2,381,778 were \$94,280 higher than last year. The increase in annual revenues was primarily due to increases in offertory and other donations, including the Apple Challenge, partly offset by the absence of COVID government assistance received in the prior year. Electronic giving for the fiscal year represented 60% of total offertory, which allowed for giving in a COVID-friendly manner. We thank

you for your continued generosity and commitment to our parish and take the stewardship of these funds as our utmost responsibility.

Overall expenses for the Fourth Quarter were \$499,743, an increase of \$66,112 from last year. Annual expenses of \$1,954,570 were \$195,945 higher than last year. The quarterly and annual increases were primarily driven by higher facility expense related to parking lot repaving, replacement of air conditioning units and payments toward upgrading the obsolete audio equipment in the Church.

The second collections for the Parish Debt Reduction Fund raised \$26,850 in the Fourth Quarter and \$99,391 for this Fiscal Year. Due to your generosity, we were able to make the final principal payment on the Church Loan and a \$47,000 principal payment on the rectory loam. We will continue to make additional principal payments during the year using the Debt Reduction Fund collections and any other available income in excess of our normal expenses.
