I understand that there are a lot of asks with the church, schools, and rectory capital campaigns, however, the necessity of maintaining the weekly offertory and ministries is paramount.


Because in the end, You are the Church.




WHAT WE DO



LATINO COMMUNITY

Each Sunday approximately 250 adults and their children join together in worship at the Spanish Mass.

Yearly an average of 15 children receive First Communion. Five babies are Baptized monthly. 31 Candidates and 1 Catechumen participated in the Spanish RCIA program.

In spring of 2020 our Indonesian Community will celebrate it's 20th Anniversary at OLA!



It is only through your generosity that OLA can serve this community through our liturgy, religious education, and our ministries and outreach. (This does not include financials from OLA School.)



ANNUAL GIVING SUMMARY




This represents the Offertory and Debt Reduction Funds (in \$1,000s) received over the past four years.

CONTRIBUTORS/DONATIONS BY ANNUAL GIVING RANGES




FUNDS: SOURCES AND USES (Thousands of Dollars)
