### From the Pastor's Desk

Dear OLA Parishioners and Supporters,

Thank you to all our parishioners for your ongoing support of our parish, staff, and many ministries. I am happy to report that OLA is in very good financial condition. We are a vibrant, financially stable parish and I hope that we continue to maintain that standing, while also growing our parish to fit the needs of you, our parish family.

Our parish is blessed with over 1,600 registered families and individuals with over 75 ministries that serve you in worship, education, and service – along with social ministries. Over the 2017-2018 fiscal year 130 new families joined our parish. This continued growth requires us to maintain, if not increase, our existing staff as more people create a greater demand on my personnel. This growth has also increased the need for financial support of ministries – and even an increase in the number of ministries that serve the community. Our recent parish survey has also added to our ministries and the work of my staff.

Back in the fall of 2005 we dedicated our "new" Church and Preschool/Youth Room/Moylan Hall. As these facilities age, maintenance costs have increased. Over the 2017-2018 fiscal year such maintenance expenses included upgrading all the air-condition units in the church. Parking lot lights as well as all lights in the church were converted to LED technology. A list of major expenses can be found in this financial report.



The parish Rectory Project will be moving forward soon. This project - consisting of a new rectory, renovation of the old rectory into new parish offices, and converting the old parish offices into OLA School offices - is the final stage of construction for the entire campus. We have nowhere else to grow in the future. We ask all parishioners to consider an additional contribution to fund this worthy project. The expansion will result in additional meeting space, an Indonesian Priest, and retired religious to serve our parish.



It is only through your generosity that Our Lady of the Assumption can serve this community through our liturgy, through our religious education, and through our Christian outreach.

I wish to express my sincere gratitude to all of you for your ongoing commitment to Christian Discipleship and Stewardship of all that we have and hold. As Stewards entrusted with the gift of treasure, we know that we have a responsibility to return to the Lord a just and fair portion of all that we have been given. Today I invite you to reflect on your response as a disciple and to the commitment that you are being asked to consider as part of your faith journey and, if you are able, to increase your financial support of our growing parish.

Finally, I would like to thank my Financial Council, Parish Council, and Ministry Commission for their hard work supporting our parish and their invaluable service to me as advisory committees.

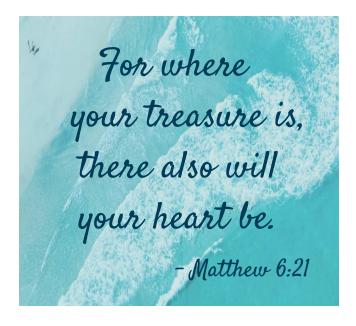

## FINANCIAL STEWARDSHIP

We are grateful for those of you who have chosen to support the good works of our parish. Our continuing challenge is to work to instill in all parishioners this same spirit of stewardship, commitment, and support for our parish.

Your commitment to financial stewardship will ensure that OLA continues to be available to respond to your needs and to the needs of the community.

#### MINISTRY HIGHLIGHTS

Listed below are just a few of the many wonderful things that OLA Ministries accomplished during the 2017 - 2018 fiscal year. If you aren't already a member of one of our ministries, please check us out at www.olachurch.org to see how you can get involved.

Loaves and Fishes Ministry provided over 250 meals to 17 families.

**Engaged Couples Ministry** worked with 10 couples preparing for marriage.

Women's Circle Ministry's Chili Cook-off raised over \$2000 to pay for updated LED lighting and rewiring of Moylan Hall.

Prime Timer's Ministry for Adults aged 65+ was formed to great success!

Athletics Ministry and additional Major Donors funded and installed the parish's electronic sign by the gym. Throughout the year our youth participated in basketball (390), soccer (230), volleyball (25), and cross country (38).

Scouting at OLA continues to grow; Girl Scouts (120), Cub Scouts (160), and Boy Scouts (74).

**Adopt-A-Cop Ministry's** 191 families/individuals (plus preschool, OLA School, and youth ministry) adopted 59 members of the Brookhaven Police Department and supported numerous BPD activities.

**St. Vincent de Paul Ministr**y assisted 624 people, donated \$500 monthly to a poor parish in Jamaica, donated funds to build two homes in Puerto Rico, and sent \$10,000 to a start-up parish in Cartersville.

**The Confirmation Preparation Team** comprised of 7 adult leaders and 12 teen leaders prepared 70 of our youth to receive the sacrament of Confirmation - our biggest class to date!

**Meals for Marists Ministry** provided weekly Sunday dinners for our priests and assisted with 13 other parish events from receptions to formal dinners at the rectory.

**Just Faith Ministry** raised over \$1700 toward their 4th house to be built for Food for the Poor. They also collected for Stand Up For Kids: \$810 cash, \$1125 gift cards, 208 pairs of socks, and toiletries.

The Parish Life Group hosted numerous events for the parish, including the inaugural Trunk-or-Treat with over 300 in attendance!
