FINANCIALS

Thank you to the OLA community for another strong financial year. Donations to the 2017-18 Annual Fund set a record for the third year in a row. This is no small feat when our community is simultaneously funding the Capital Campaign effort. Thank you! The Annual Fund provides stability to the financial foundation of OLA School, and it is that strong foundation that allows the school to grow and prosper.

Evidence of growth can be seen most clearly through the success of the OLA School Capital Campaign. Income received for the Capital Campaign during the 2017-18 year totaled \$1,094,062. In addition, OLA school will put 10% of all fundraising efforts toward Capital Campaign costs until the project is paid off.

Thank you to everyone who has pledged support for the addition to OLA School. The summer of 2018 saw proof of that support in the form of construction, which will continue into the 2018-19 school year.

The cost to educate each child at OLA during the 2017-18 school year was \$9,872 compared to tuition of \$8,650 for Catholic students. The \$1,223 difference is made up through the Annual Fund and other fundraising. Long-range financial stability remains an important goal for Our Lady of the Assumption Catholic School, and that stability depends upon giving through the Annual Fund and other fundraising efforts. Thank you to everyone whose financial support made a successful school year possible.
