Greetings from Queen of Angels Catholic School!

It is my pleasure to share with you the 2020-2021 annual report, highlighting many of the successes we have had in the past year. This definitely has been a year of unknowns and challenges but thanks to your prayers and continued support we continue to persevere in a year where the theme of HOPE guided us and allowed for a successful school year. Despite the lingering effects of the pandemic, our goals continue to be to Encounter Christ, Empower Students, and Engage Community.

When COVID-19 required us to suspend in-person learning in March of 2020, our faculty and staff pivoted, and within a week had created a wonderful education program for students. As we began the new school year, these dedicated men and women used the experience they had gained to create two platforms for learning - both in-person as well as students at



home. We utilized a variety of technologies to make this happen and became a 1:1 school with Chrome-books in the hands of every student in grades 3-8, a key to our success. New for the 2021-2022 school year will be the establishment of a new fiber optic cable for upgraded internet service, security cameras on the QA fields, and new Chrome devices at every grade level.

As a Catholic school, I am most pleased that despite the guidelines that were in place, we were able to continue the pursuit of "spiritual excellence" through weekly Mass, Adoration, Reconciliation, service projects, retreats, and opportunities to share the faith with the greater community. Per our tagline, the goal to "Encounter Christ" is at the foundation of all we do so that we can prepare students for their roles in high school, their parishes, communities, and ultimately for eternity.

This report highlights the generosity of so many individuals who have supported the advancement efforts of Queen of Angels. It is remarkable that during the pandemic we reached an unprecedented 100% participation by our families, faculty, and staff. In addition, the overwhelming support of the Gala on the Green has allowed for the vision of refurbishing the primary pod to become a reality. We are extremely grateful for these gifts, as well as the gifts of time, talents, and prayers shared throughout the year.

Throughout the 21 years that Queen of Angels Catholic School has served the greater community, we are very fortunate to have the strong traditions and foundation due to the efforts so many of you have



made. These will forever be cherished and passed on and supported by new families who enroll at our school and grow to love Queen of Angels!


