Letter From the Principal

Dear Friends of St. John Neumann,

It is because of you that we can truly celebrate the growth and positive changes we have experienced this past year. Equally important was your support through the challenges we faced, especially the whole lower level becoming uninhabitable due to a flood caused by a broken pipe for almost four months .

This year you welcomed a new Principal, Business Manager, Advancement Director, and a front office Administrative Assistant. Although, this amount of change could easily set an institution back until the team is well established, it was the quality and commitment of our Advisory Council, Home and School Association, and our existing faculty and staff that helped preserve the traditions that make us who we are and put the time and effort into implementing needed changes.

Your contributions supported the needed changes these dedicated teams were able to make. The changes made this past year include, but are not limited to, the update to the lobby and the creation of a welcoming community space, the establishment of the Parent Room, the launch of a new and updated website, the creation of unified and current marketing materials, the implementation of the Crusader Classic Golf Tournament, the Color Run, Penny Wars, and community work days. All of these changes have strengthened our community, provided a unified brand, and established new traditions that will support our continued growth.



We also saw growth in several areas, the first being enrollment. We added fifteen new students over the school year, created a new full day pre-kindergarten and had it fully enrolled by May, and our kindergarten and first grade had waiting lists for 2018-2019. Second, the technology program continued to grow. We have increased our one to one technology to the fourth grade and added eight new ClearTouch Interactive Boards to our homerooms. This has exponentially increased the learning opportunities for all of our students. Finally, the Home and School Association put the third and final upgrade to our playground. We were able to replace the foundational material making it a much safer area to play and added three new pieces of equipment.

Traditions abound at St. John Neumann. Again, your participation and financial support make this possible. The Back to School Bash, Fall Festival, Sandwich Build Service Project, Food Baskets at Thanksgiving and Christmas, International Dinner, Retreats, Teacher Appreciation activities, Spelling Bee, Civic Oration, Field Trips, Neulympics and your willingness to being called to action to support victims of natural disaster are only a few of these that make us unique.
