Dear Fellow Parishioners,

We are pleased to provide you with our Fiscal Year 2017-18 Annual Stewardship Report. This report highlights how your support enabled our parish to continue our mission of worship, spiritual growth, and service to others.

Our offertory increased by 7.7% and contributions to the Archbishop's Annual Appeal once again generated a refund. The increases in your support were primarily used to fund capital improvements of \$353,000. Overall, the parish operated at a surplus of approximately \$220,000 and that allowed us to make principal payments of over \$172,000 on our parish loan, reducing the balance owed to under \$1,500,000.

By supporting the parish and participating in our many programs, you become living examples of how each one of us can *Be the Church*. Without you, none of this is possible. We thank you for sharing your time, talent, and treasure.
