Dear St. Luke parishioners,

With this letter, I'm publishing our parish financial data for the previous fiscal year, which runs from July 1 to June 30. You can view our parish annual financial report, including the Income and Expense Summary and our Balance Sheet on our website here: www.stlukercc.org. If you do not have internet access, we can print a copy for you if you stop by at our parish offices in the administration building from Tuesday - Thursday, 9am-2pm.

It is worthwhile to note that in the period after Fr. John left and until I began on July 1, there were no priest salary and rectory expenses paid by St. Luke because the priest was paid by the Archdiocese of Atlanta. Since July 1, 2019, the priest salary and rectory expenses are being paid by St. Luke. We have implemented cost controls, reduced staff and hours due to the shortfall in budgeted offerings. We have gone from four to three days of the office being open, and we are one less person in the office. As we look at the financial picture of this fiscal year, it is important to note that we have been facing additional expenses due to the asbestos abatement of the administration building and associated costs and HVAC repairs. St. Luke has no long term debt.

I want to take this opportunity to thank all of you, once again, for your support of St. Luke. We do continue to run behind in this year's modest offertory budget, and we are in need of help to reach our goal. In my short time here so far, I have witnessed a good level of giving to our general offertory, which is a wonderful testament to your generosity and love for our parish. We have made our annual appeal goal. I give thanks to God for you. I also thank the finance committee for their dedication and continued work in regards to our financial matters. As the end of the calendar year approaches, please continue to keep our parish in mind for your planned giving. If you have any questions or comments regarding our financial statements please feel free to contact me or a member of our finance council.
