Highlights

Renovation of St. Vincent de Paul Building

The Environmental Ministry had an energy audit completed of our entire campus. In it, we learned that our energy costs for the St. Vincent de Paul building were unreasonably high compared to the other buildings. The audit was used to write a grant request to the Catholic Foundation of North Georgia for the renovation of the building to make it more energy efficient. We were able to install a new walk-in refrigeration unit, and remove the old inefficient refrigerators and freezers. We also added insulation, a new Heating and Air Conditioning system, and more indoor seating.

Scout Building

The renovations to the Scout Building has allowed us to host more meetings and events in a beautiful space with a functioning kitchen. There are brochures that detail the renovation in the gathering space.

We have also renovated the San Damiano House and resolved a persistent mold issue. We turned the St. Clare room into an office for the counselor, Nanci Goggins, from Catholic Charities.

We received a **return of \$24,327.31** from the Archbishop's Annual Appeal during 2016-2017. This amount exceeded our pledged goal.

Thanks to your generous donations, we were able to use the excess to renovate the St. Vincent de Paul building, and save the parish money on utilities!

However, over the past three years, the number of families participating in the Archbishop's Annual Appeal has steadily decreased by an average of 30 families per year!

Our parish is growing, but our monetary contributions are not reflecting our population growth. Hello Family,

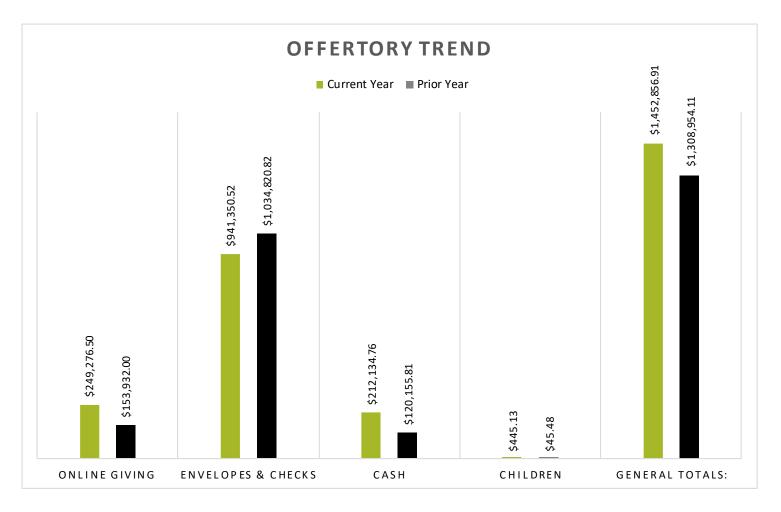

What do these numbers mean?

We are spending more than we are receiving in offertory. Ideally, offertory should cover all of the Parish's expenses with excess to place in savings.

*Capital totals are not actual income. The income from this account primarily comes from our Capital Savings account. It is more accurately described as a transfer rather than revenue.

An endowment is a donation of money or property to a non-profit (i.e. St. Philip Benizi) for the ongoing support of that entity. The gain or loss on endowment is the amount that we gain or lose from the investments made by the Catholic Foundation of North Georgia.

- School Subsidy Expense was \$124,123.35 for 2015-2016 and \$139,119.43 for 2016-2017. That is a \$14,996.08 increase. This is money that we pay the Archdiocese to help subsidize Catholic Schools.
- Our General Assessment to the Archdiocese of Atlanta (Archdiocese Support) was \$154,475.22 for 2015-2016 and \$231,517.20 for 2016-2017. The Archdiocese of Atlanta uses the general assessment to operate and provide help and resources to parishes in need.
- ◆ The School Subsidy and Archdiocese Support total 18.36% of our total expenses.

Did you Know?

- On average, our team of Counters count over 600 envelopes, 300 loose checks, and lots of cash on a weekly basis. ..add another 300 envelopes for second collections!
- Most second collections do not belong to St. Philip Benizi. They are sent directly to the Archdiocese to assist with specific causes (i.e. Campaign for Human Development, Retirement for Religious, etc.)

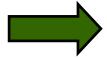

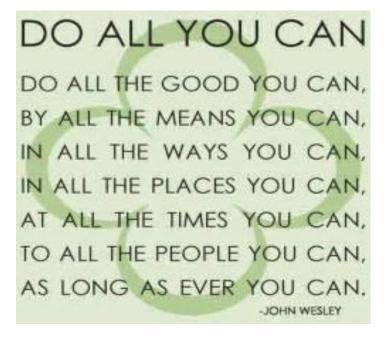
