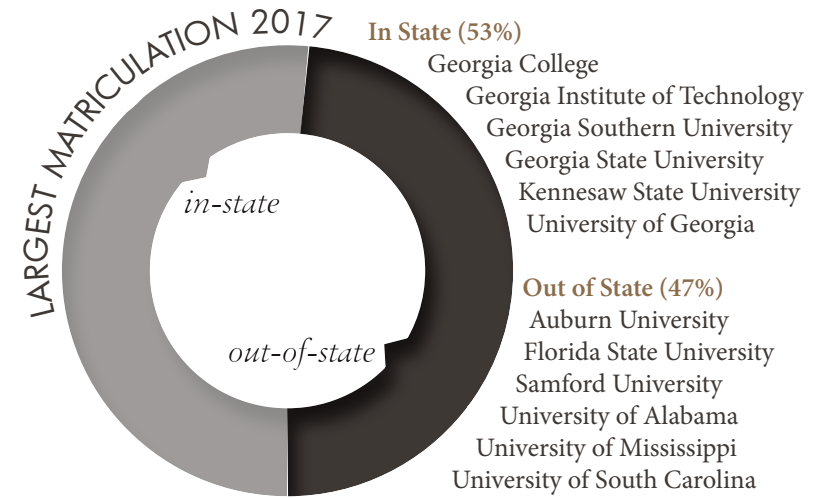

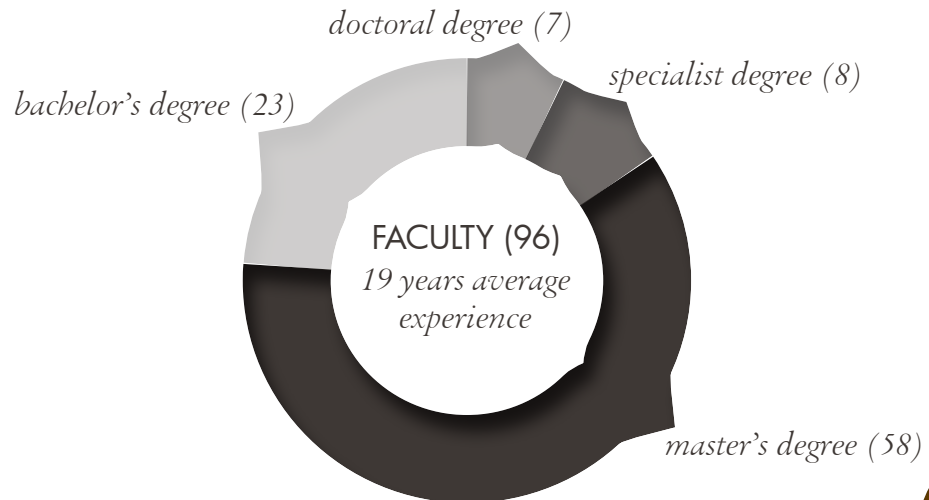

St. Pius X Catholic High School *welcomed its first president, Mr. Chad Barwick*. The role of the president is to keep the school true to its mission, ensuring that it moves forward, growing and strengthening while planning for the future. St. Pius X is the first school in the Archdiocese of Atlanta to employ a president.

Under direction of Ms. Lindsay Dent and Ms. Melissa Page, the St. Pius X Writing Center offered one-on-one tutoring in all subject areas. Writing Center Peer Tutors provided targeted assistance throughout all levels of writing and drafting. *Over 50 students*

Science instructor *Mrs. Lutricia Barnett published her first young adult novel, Accidental Arrival*. Part one of a trilogy, the book follows the main character on adventures to a different galaxy. The St. Pius X Book Club hosted a book signing event where 50 students received copies of the novel and many others enjoyed conversation with the author.

The St. Pius X *Christmas Classic celebrated its 16th year of hosting Catholic schools from across the nation*. Sixteen schools from eight states played basketball and enjoyed fellowship over the three day event. The tournament, which began with a Mass and banquet, saw Brother Martin (LA) win the boys' championship, while Fr. Ryan (TN) captured the girls' championship for the second consecutive year.

Joining forces with Our Lady of the Assumption Catholic School once again, *the St. Pius X community donated over 300 backpacks and small tote bags to the WSB-TV Totes 2 Tots program*. The program helps provide bags for children in the foster care system in Georgia.

St. Pius X *parent organizations offered a variety of ways for parents and students to give back*. The Mothers' Club held their annual Winter Service Day in February where they worked on projects to benefit five organizations; Pillows for Pam, St. Vincent de Paul Toiletries for the Homeless, Project Snuggle Bug, St. Jude Greeting Card Program, and Letters for Soldiers. The Home and School Association teamed up with FosterCares, where parent and student volunteers spent a day organizing a space full of clothing, equipment, toys, and more, in an effort to give foster families a place to shop for their children. The group tackled tasks such as sorting and sizing clothing, assembling toys, and organizing storage areas.

took advantage of the tutoring program for assigned essay projects for a variety of classes or for college essays.

Class of 2014 alumni Gunnar Bentz *earned a gold medal in the 4x200 freestyle relay at the Rio Olympic Games*. Bentz swam on the relay team in the preliminary round, and helped his team earn the No. 2 seed. He is the second Golden Lion Olympian (Ralph King '74, track and field), and the first Golden Lion to win a gold medal in an Olympiad.

On September 2, the school *celebrated longtime volunteers Tom and Joanne Novack with a special evening* to kick-off their "retirement." Tom, and his loving wife, Joanne, managed the concession stands for 24 years. Despite having no children at the school, Tom and Joanne became St. Pius X's most well known volunteers, impacting the school community forever with their love, dedication, and commitment to our students.

Thirty students attended the March for Life in January in Washington, D.C., where they had the opportunity to attend Mass, the annual march, and a youth rally at the National Mall.

The Dance Company worked with students at the Margaret Harris Comprehensive School, a self-contained special education school for students with disabilities from ages three to 21. *The Company performed for the school, took time to interact with students, and led them through movement exercises.*

Seventy-five students took part in the third annual Domini Sumus retreat at LifeTeen's Camp Covecrest. Students enjoyed a weekend of prayer, games, Mass, the Sacrament of Reconciliation, small group time, worship, and outdoor activities. With the theme, "I in them, and You in Me," *the weekend was a wonderful way for students to reconnect with the Lord as a Pius family.*

The annual St. Pius X *Trivia Night enjoyed its highest attendance ever with 425 alumni, parents, and friends of the school*. Hosted by Michael Trujillo '01 for the ninth year, the event raised \$10,000 for the Alumni Scholarship Fund.

One of the highest honors that a sophomore or junior can receive is to be selected to participate in the Governor's Honors Program, sponsored by the State Department of Education. St. Pius X was *proud to announce two finalists for the 2017 program: Michael Wolfman (world languages, Latin) and Kierra Williams (dance)*. These students were offered the opportunity to attend the annual summer program with the finest students in academics and the arts in the state.

The 13th Annual Juried Visual Arts Exhibition was held in February and was judged by Cynthia Lollis, a professor of printmaking and book art at the Savannah College of Art and Design, and Atlanta-based artist Danielle Brutto '06. Students submitted artwork in the various categories; 3D design, ceramics, mixed media, 2D design, photography, painting, and drawing. *The first place Best in Show ribbon was awarded to Andrew Gray for his piece entitled, "Arizona."*

St. Pius X hosted its 28th blood drive since 1984. To date, *the school has donated an astounding 3,600 units of blood, making it the most successful high school blood drive in the state.* Seniors Megan Anandappa and Richard Guyton earned scholarships through the American Red Cross for their dedication over the past four years. The two believe strongly in the importance of giving blood and are regular donors at their parish and our school.

Students in Mr. Matt Lammers' AP Biology class raised over 300 rainbow trout from egg to

The National Merit Scholarship Program provides opportunities for scholarships to outstanding students throughout the country who succeed in their studies and perform with excellence on the PSAT examination. St. Pius X was *proud to announce six National Merit Scholarship Finalists.* Seniors Joshua Sam Christopher, Patrick Crawford, Matthew Desmelik, Emily Pearson, Robert Porter, and Jacob Ressler-Craig reached finalist standing, placing them in the top half of one percent of students nationwide participating in the competition. The school also proudly announced 18 Commended Students and two National Hispanic Scholars.

Twenty-five priests spent a day at St. Pius X for the Lent and Advent Penance Services, where *over 600 students took the opportunity to celebrate reconciliation.*

In an effort to live out our Catholic mission, *St. Pius X offered several opportunities for students and faculty to help those in need through out-of-uniform days.* Students were granted a free dress day in exchange for donations in support of victims of the Baton Rouge flooding, victims of the fire at a Dresden apartment complex, and on Heritage Day for the benefit of the Grey Nuns of the Sacred Heart, founding members of the school. Students and faculty *raised a total of nearly \$14,500 for the cause.*

Visual arts students *Cecilia Barnes '17, Emma Buyarski '18, Ali Grijak '17, and Mae Cannon '18 had pieces selected for the Georgia High School Ceramics Symposium.* Barnes' "Portrait Bust" took home an honorable mention. At the annual Scholastic Art and Writing Awards held at the Savannah College of Art and Design, juniors Emmie Barnhardt and John Huynh won honorable mention and silver key awards, respectively.

The Pius Players held *another outstanding season, beginning with their performance of The Last Day of School. In November, the actors put on an unforgettable performance of Anne Frank and Me.* To wrap up their season, the group enthralled families with *Honk! The Musical.*

Sponsored by the Class of 2017 Student Government, the entire school pulled together to participate in the *first ever school-wide Works of Mercy project.* Teaming up with Rise Against Hunger, students and faculty worked together to organize three stations and build meals. *The school packaged a total of 35,000 meals,* each containing soy protein, vitamin and mineral supplements, and rice.

Page Hamilton, of the nineties band Helmet, held a guitar masterclass and free music career lecture for students. Earlier in the year, *the artist was commissioned by the band program to write an original piece.* Entitled "St. Pius:

Led by science instructor Mrs. Brigid Bartholomai, the RoboLions (the St. Pius X Robotics Club) *increased their membership to 20 students this year.* The group built three robots and entered four VEX competitions, featuring game-based engineering challenges where students must design, build, and program robots to play against teams from across the state. *Skills learned in this club will prepare students in future computer science and mechanical engineering pursuits.* The group advanced to the quarterfinal round twice and the semifinal round once in competitions.

The fine arts department had a very successful year, selling out a number of performances, including the Dance Concert and the Guitar and Chorus Concert. *Students worked hard and displayed their talents before audiences totaling more than 4,900 people.* This number is made even higher when you include the NOVO Choreography & Benefit Project and the Juried Arts Exhibition, neither of which sell tickets but enjoy very large audiences.



For the third year in a row, the St. Pius X Advanced Guitar Ensemble received a superior rating at the Large Group Performance Evaluation (LGPE) in the state of Georgia. Held for all disciplines of music, the event offers musicians an opportunity to come together and share their talents. *The superior rating is the highest score students can receive.*

Juliana Nark '18 and Nick Poulos '18 won top recognition in the 2017 National Council of Teachers of English Achievement Awards in Writing program. Their submissions were evaluated by one high school teacher and one college English teacher. St. Pius X has had the honor of claiming 43 recipients since 1969.

Teachers in various subjects broke out of traditional lesson plans with "escape rooms." With each escape room, students were given a mission and an hour to solve puzzles and discover clues related to their class in order to "escape" in the fastest time. With the help of the BreakoutEDU kits containing locks, flashlights, and hint cards, among other items, faculty members gave students a fun and new way to learn material.

championships, (boys' cross country, boys' swim and dive and girls' soccer) and two state runners-up, (boys' basketball and girls' tennis). The school celebrated an additional five region championships with boys' cross country, volleyball, boys' basketball, girls' soccer and girls' lacrosse.

Earning a total of 39 medals, students who participated in the annual National French Contest rose to the challenge and performed with distinction with nearly 30 percent placing at the national level. *Earning the top score in the nation in her respective level, Margherita Ceccagnoli '20 was named a Platinum winner, the highest award in Le Grand Concours.* The annual program is sponsored by the American Association of Teachers of French and includes a nationwide written test.

Fifteen members of the Class of 2017 intend to continue their athletic careers in college. Only one will remain in the state of Georgia while the remaining 14 will matriculate to schools across

in the stands, on the fields, and on the courts. This is the fifth time St. Pius X has earned this prestigious award.

Nominated by her department, *Dr. Liberty Hall was voted Teacher of the Year by the faculty for her years of service and dedication to teaching.* Hall has been a member of the theology department for eight years.

Mr. Sean Hiland was selected for the Excellence in Teaching Award for his ability to reach students of all levels, support of the school's mission, and his commitment to professional development. Hiland has been a member of the social studies department for the past 15 years.

St. Pius X students took a total of 1,049 Advanced Placement (AP) exams with 184 students earning the distinction of AP Scholar.



The Student Teacher Achievement Recognition (STAR) program honors Georgia's outstanding high school seniors and the teachers who have been most instrumental in their academic development. This year, *St. Pius X was proud to announce senior Jacob Ressler-Craig as the STAR student and social studies instructor Ms. Kristin Kramer as the 2016-17 STAR teacher.*

The Office of Advancement presented a challenge to the Class of 2017 to be the first class to "Go Out Golden," and give back to St. Pius X through the Annual Fund. *The campaign was a huge success and the class did not disappoint; the group earned the highest participation of all alumni at 31 percent,* followed by the Class of 1966 with 13 percent participation. In total, the Annual Fund raised over \$850,000 for the school.

The Golden Lions put together *another exciting athletic season winning three state*

the country. This marks the seventh straight year more than ten student-athletes will further their careers.

Coach Sara Schmitt and the girls' soccer team were *ranked second in the nation in the USA Today Sports Super 25 Expert Rankings.* The team captured the state championship for the fifth time in a row this past year. Coach Schmitt has held the head coaching position for the past ten years, during which time the team has taken eight state trophies, one national title, and one state runner-up.

Coach Scott Carter was named Georgia High School Association Swimming and Diving Coach of the Year. Carter has led his team to two state championship wins and three state runners-up, including a boys' title in 2016-17.

St. Pius X was the *proud recipient of the Georgia High School Association's Cooperative Spirit Award.* Voted on by principals and athletic directors from the region, this award recognizes schools with the highest degree of sportsmanship

Eighteen of these students were named National AP Scholars, having received an average score of at least four on all AP exams taken, and scores of four or higher on eight or more of these exams.

Two-hundred and fifty-six members from the Class of 2017 graduated on May 18 at Symphony Hall, *becoming the 59th graduating class of St. Pius X.* President Chad Barwick, Principal Steve Spellman, valedictorian Emily Pearson, and salutatorian Jacob Ressler-Craig addressed the group, reminiscing on their successful years. *Captain James Wyatt '78 joined the faculty on stage as he was honored as the 2017 Distinguished Alumnus.* Archbishop Wilton D. Gregory distributed diplomas and proudly presented his annual Archbishop's Award to Sarah Marshall and Bennett Hardee.

Joining forces for the first time, in June, the football and alumni sponsored golf tournaments became the George B. Maloof Lion Nation Golf and Tennis Classic. *The event brought together supporters of the St. Pius X community and raised \$32,000 for the football program and the St. Pius X Alumni Scholarship Fund.*

The Class of 2017 graduated with the highest SAT and ACT scores in the history of St. Pius X Catholic High School. The graduates completed a record 1,379 applications and were accepted at 193 colleges and universities. They have matriculated to 81 schools across the United States. The group earned an astounding \$18 million in scholarship money (a number that does not include HOPE or athletic scholarships).
