## Annual Report July 1, 2019—June 30, 2020

This year is like no other for our families, community and country. Prior to the COVID 19 Pandemic, and resulting shut-down of the parish from March 21, 2020 through May 30, 2020, financially the parish was struggling to meet our expenses. The addition of the gym/youth center and aging of our current buildings, the increased facilities cost was having an impact. The minimal increase in collections came to a halt in March and the year ended with collection level of 4% below the previous year. While sources of revenue decreased, many of our expenses are at a fixed level which contributes to the deficit position for the year. Efforts have been made to cut costs and this effort will continue so the parish can meet its' financial obligations this upcoming year. Further cost cutting will be necessary without increased offertory.

We do want to thank all the parishioners that have continued to financially support the parish throughout the year. Our prayers are for your spiritual and physical health and that we will soon be able again to worship as a full community.
