Our 2023-24 school year was again marked by our pursuit of excellence for and by our students.

A proof of this as an ongoing guiding principle of STM school is the Cognia STEM certification that we applied for and received in 2024. Achieving the

certification required an application, school self-assessments, and finally a rigorous onsite visitation and review by the Cognia Global Commission. We received notice of our certification in late summer 2024.

With accreditation, STM joins the ranks of over 400 institutions in 35 states and across 15 countries assessed and validated by Cognia for the quality, rigor, and substance of their STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics) education programs. Our attention to excellence in STEM places our students in good standing not only for high school success, but also far beyond – from college to career.

We're excited to have earned this recognition, symbolizing our commitment to foster innovation, critical thinking, and experiential learning for all of our students.

In addition, our 2023-24 school year marked the beginning of STM Parish and School fundraising for exciting new construction which includes a new K-5 school building, a turf field, and an improved space for Pre-K4 and the school office. STM SCHOOL AT A GLANCE

Saint Thomas More Catholic School opened on September 1, 1950 with approximately 140 children in grades one through five. The Sisters of Notre Dame de Namur staffed the school. Grades six, seven, and eight were added in successive years. In 2016, STM School became the Archdiocese of Atlanta's only parochial primary school in the Jesuit Tradition and was also named a Blue Ribbon School.

Classes range from Pre-K4 through eighth grade with two classes per grade level. We provide a comprehensive curriculum in language arts, mathematics, religion, science, and social studies, as well as art, music, physical education, Spanish, and STREAM.
