The Annual Fund enables us to afford upgrades and make purchases throughout the school that are not included in our budget. This year we upgraded our sound systems in the gym and cafeteria, purchased water fountain/water bottle filling stations for all areas of the school, as well as instructional books and materials with an emphasis on new social studies materials in grades 3-6 and geography kits for grades K-5. We were also able to allocate a portion of the funds raised towards our own local tuition assistance fund to help those families who need financial support.
