Liabilities Explanations: At the end of each fiscal year accruals are made for Prepaid Preschool Tuition, Mass Stipends, Ministries, and Other Exchanges. The accrual for the fiscal years ending 2019 and 2020 respectively, are paid out in the subsequent fiscal period. These liability accounts are maintained on the parish books with specific parish accounts where monies are collected and subsequently distributed, dollar for dollar, to their designated organizations.

Our Columbarium requires monies to be set aside for perpetual care (at 14% of sales on a monthly bases), and personal scrolls as niche/s are sold, including relocation if necessary. The Endowment Funds are held with The Catholic Foundation of North Georgia.

Paycheck Protection Program Loan is listed under assets and liabilities. The Archdiocese was instrumental in getting monies for parishes to assist them to continue payments for salaries, benefits, and some operating expenses.
